Dear Sir,

During the first Bi-lateral meeting between Management of ONGC and CEC representatives of ASTO held at New Delhi on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2012, a number of issues had been raised by the ASTO for their early resolutions.


ASTO had been entrusted to suggest action on certain issues. One such issue is regarding the stamp duty paid by the employees on ONGC HBA Loan. Currently the stamp duty is Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand Only), which is very high. This stamp duty is also not being reimbursed.

In comparison the stamp duty charged by various nationalized as well as private banks is very less. For example, the stamp duty charged by the Bank of Baroda in case of Amrapali Group Housing loan scheme, Delhi was Rs. 250/-(Rupees Two Hundred Fifty only) for any loan amount.

It is requested that the issue may be discussed with the legal department and if possible, the stamp duty may be reduced to Rs. 250.
